Remembrance Sunday 11 November

There will be an Act of Remembrance after the 10am Mass at 10.50am, outside the cathedral. Please assemble on the pavement in front of the cross. The 11.30am Mass will be a Requiem Mass for all those killed in War & Conflict celebrated by Archbishop Peter.

To mark the centenary of the end of World War One there will be a Service of Thanksgiving and Prayer of Peace at 3pm in Southwark Anglican Cathedral. Canon Richard will be preaching, and our choir will be taking part. All are warmly invited.
